Each troop will reserve it's own camp site, by contacting the Scout Service Center, and will provide its own camping equipment and food. (There is no additional fee for the campsite.)

Program will begin Saturday at 8:30 am and will end at 4:00 pm. There will be a campfire on Saturday evening so bring your skits and songs to join in the fun. Troops can check in on Friday evening or Saturday morning and check out will be Sunday by noon.

Webelos:

- Can camp for weekend, but must have proper adult supervision (either parent and son teams or two leaders at all times) and bring their own equipment.
- Must supply their own meals. Webelos are suggested to partner with a Troop. O/A trading post will be open for lunch.
- Will be involved in the activities with the Boy Scouts, however, they will not be involved in any competitions.
