**Boy Scouts Celebrate 100 Years of Scouting**

The Blue Water Council, BSA and the Port Huron Museum are teaming up to help celebrate the “100<sup>th</sup> Year of Scouting” in the United States. The Port Huron Museum is dedicating the whole main floor for this exhibit which runs from **February 6 through April 25, 2010. We need your help!!**

1. Do you have any **Scout Memorabilia** you can lend us? (We will photograph the items, list what you lend us and make sure you get everything back in good condition.)
2. We need a **Patch Design** for the 100th Anniversary BSA Museum Exhibit. The design must be submitted to the Scout Service Center by November 15, 2009. (This limited edition patch will be given to youth visiting the museum during this exhibit.)
3. We need 25 great **Scout Stories**. (There will be stories around the campfire... we can record them or you can do them in person.)
4. We need 30 people to build **Pinewood Derby Cars** to be used during the museum display for anyone wanting to test a car. A Pinewood Derby Track will be set up during the display. (We will give away 30 cars for people to design, build and bring back to the Scout Service Center for use at the museum. These cars must be turned back in to the Scout Service Center by December 1, 2009.)
5. **Pinewood Derby Car Design Competition** – Theme 100<sup>th</sup> BSA Anniversary  
Buy a Pinewood Derby Car at the Scout Shop, design and build a car and turn it in to the Port Huron Museum by January 6, 2010. There will be three divisions: Cub Scouts, Boy Scouts and Adults. A \$50 prize will be awarded to the winner in each division. All entries will be in display cases at the museum during the exhibit. These cars will not be raced only displayed.
6. We are looking for local **Eagle Scouts**. Give us your name and year you received your Eagle Rank; we want to put together a complete list of all Eagles in our Council. 7. We also need **Scout Volunteers** to lead some demonstrations at the museum or help in other ways.
