ALL SCOUTS WILL TRAVEL IN FULL UNIFORM

-Proper Uniforms are essential, due to the large number of people with whom the Scouts will come in contact with.
 - **WARNING:** Work Clothing is needed and should be used on work assignments. These assignments do often involve paints or stains that may permanently stain clothing.

- **SHOES: BROWN DECK SHOES** are required for both Guide and Flag Duty.
 Tennis Shoes or Boots may be worn when Scouts are off duty or working on a service project.

- REQUIRED PERSONAL EQUIPMENT:

The following is a list of the personal equipment that is required for your week on Mackinac Island. This list is not all inclusive; You may have other items you wish to bring. If you have any questions please contact any adult leader.

- One (1) Boy Scout webbed belt and buckle
- Two (2) Pair of Uniform Cotton Canvas Pants
- Two (2) Pair of Crew Uniform Socks
- Two (2) **Short** Sleeve Cotton Uniform Shirts
(Complete with proper insignias)
(No Long Sleeve Shirts)
- One (1) Scout Uniform Cap
- Two (2) Boy Scout Uniform Neckerchief Slides
- One (1) Pair Brown Leather Deck Shoes
- One (1) Clear Plastic Poncho
- One (1) Plain Red Jacket
(No insignia or Names)
(Red O/A Jacket is OK.)
- One (1) Wristwatch
(It is a MUST to be able to know what time it is.)

Personal Gear

- Sweatshirt, Sweater, or Warm Jacket
- Extra Underwear
- Extra socks
- Soap (In a Container), Shampoo, Deodorant
- Comb/ Brush, Toothbrush & Paste
- Towel & Washcloth
- Sleeping Bag or Blankets & Sheets
- Pillow
- Flashlight
- Scout Handbook, Merit Badge Books
- Pen, Pencil, Paper, and stamps
(to write home)
- Work Clothes (Service Projects)
- Play Clothes (Sports, Off Duty, etc.)

Optional

- Camera Baseball Glove Books
- Musical Instruments
- Pocket Money (Max \$50.00 recommended)

Mark all clothing and personal items with owner's name.
 Use Permanent Marker in an inconspicuous place.

Please pack all clothing and personal items in a lockable case or bag with a lock.

Adult Leaders are not responsible for boys clothing.

A Maximum of \$50.00 is recommended for pocket money.

\$10.00 should be held in reserve for lunch on the way home.
