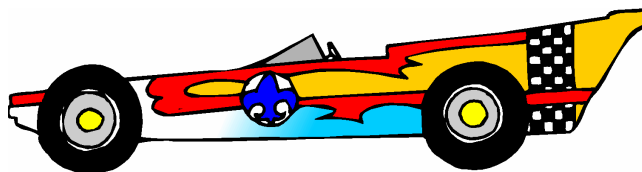


Pinewood Derby Car Design Competition
