The Blue Water Council invites registered youth and adults to participate in the Florida Sea Base, Keys Adventure program in 2011 at the Brinton Environmental Center on Islamorada Island, Florida Keys between the Gulf of Mexico and Atlantic Ocean. There are four (4) adult positions and twelve (12) youth positions available. All youth applying must be 14 by September 1, 2011 and not older than 20 years of age and registered in a Boy Scout Troop, Venturing Crew or Sea Scout Ship. All adults must be at least 21 years old to apply and registered through the Blue Water Council. Age requirements are not flexible, please do not expect an exception.

All youth and adults must pass a Sea Base health physical and BSA swim test. Medical forms, participant guides and gear lists will be given out after the contingent application process is complete.

Cost of the Adventure—\$1350 Experience—Priceless!

Sea Base Fees will cover all expenses for the week including travel to and from the Sea Base Brinton Environmental Center, all adventures, and food. Souvenirs are extra. A payment plan is included for your convenience, to minimize fee amounts due over a period of eleven months.
